



WILDLIFE COMMITTEE CHARTER

PREAMBLE

The By-Laws of the Bull Point Plantation Property Owners Association (BBPOA) provides the Board of Directors (BOD) with the authority to appoint committees “as it deems appropriate” in carrying out its purpose. Pursuant to such authority, the BOD has appointed the Wildlife Committee to provide it with advice and counsel to carry out the BOD’s purpose, as delineated in this charter, and as may be revised from time to time by decisions approved by a vote of a majority of the members of the BOD.

The BOD has authorized the elected Chairperson of this Committee to inform the BOD of the status of ongoing endeavors undertaken by the committee, and, in turn, to provide the Committee with guidance and direction as to the policies, decisions, and priorities of the BOD to ensure that the ongoing work of the Committee is consistent with its Charter and the BOD’s purpose.

PURPOSE/RESPONSIBILITIES

The Wildlife Committee is established to assist the BOD in maintaining a harmonious balance between the community’s residential nature and its surrounding natural habitat. The Committee’s purpose is to promote conservation, educate residents, protect wildlife, and provide recommendations on wildlife management to maintain Bull Point Plantation’s aesthetic and environmental value.

The Committee is responsible for the following:

- Monitor and maintain existing wildlife habitats i.e. duck boxes and bird sanctuary.
- Monitor and recommend actions regarding nuisance animal populations.
- Assist the BOD with scheduled deer surveys and deer culling procedures.
- Seek additional ways in which Bull Point Plantation can encourage and support the presence of current and additional wildlife.
- Collaborate with other Committees to find common ways to encourage and sustain our natural resources.
- Collaborate with other Committees to plan and conduct educational programs for the Bull Point Plantation community.
- Determine and propose an annual budget to the BOD for Committee activities.

REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP/REMOVAL

- The Committee shall consist of not less than three (3) members.
- Members serve at the pleasure of the BOD.
- Absence by any Committee member from three (3) or more consecutive meetings. without excuse will be reported to the BOD.

MEETING FREQUENCY

- The Committee shall elect a Chairperson and may rotate the Chair amongst the members at the discretion of the Committee
- The BOD will be notified of Chairperson changes when they occur
- The Committee shall meet at least quarterly
- The BOD may also request special meetings with the Committee

COMMUNICATION & REPORTING

- Minutes of each meeting must be recorded and submitted to the BOD within ten (10) days following each meeting. Minutes shall include the date, time, place, member attendance and all votes of the meeting
- The Chairperson may be required to report to the BOD or to a meeting of the owners

AUTHORITY

- The Committee shall not direct vendors or contractors unless and only to the extent specifically authorized by the BOD. Such authority may then be exercised by the Committee or by any member of the Committee designated by the Chairperson to act on the Committee's behalf
- Only the BOD may enter into, modify, or terminate a contract
